## Checklist for registering your resource on the Health Translations library

This checklist will help you assess if your resource meets the registration requirements for Health Translations. Please also refer to Editorial Guidelines when using this checklist.

### Please check if your resource:

- Does not already exist on the library - you can check this by running a search for your resource on the Health Translations website
- Has been published in Australia
- Fits into one of the health and wellbeing related [topics](#)
- Has been translated into languages other than English (including Auslan, Easy English and Plain Language) by a NAATI accredited translator and/or the translated version has been focused tested with consumers
- Has a corresponding English version
- Has been published or reviewed within the past three years
- Has content that takes into consideration cultural sensitivity and linguistic diversity of consumers
- Does not promote individual commercial products, therapies and services
- Does not include clinical information that has the potential to adversely affect the health of an individual
- Has been uploaded to a website with an available URL - We do not store or upload resources on to the Health Translations library, we link to resources hosted elsewhere. In order for us to link your resource, the file needs to be hosted on your (or another) organisation's website and we need to be provided with a URL.

When registering your resource, you will be also asked to provide the following information:

- Title of the resource
- Publishing date and last reviewed date (if applicable)
- 25 to 50 words summary of the resource
- URL address of English version and translated version(s)
