# Elective Surgery Information System (ESIS)

## 207.3 Reporting of PPP 509 Plastics/Aesthetic (Cosmetic) Procedures to ESIS

In line with Circular 03/2016 Ensuring surgical services in health services are provided to patients with a medical indication:

- From 1 January 2017 health services must not report any new waiting episodes to ESIS with PPP 509 *Plastics/Aesthetic (Cosmetic) Procedures*.
- Health Services must review all existing waiting episodes with PPP 509 and by 5 April 2017 either:
  - Assign an appropriate reportable PPP code for clinically indicated aesthetic procedures (refer to *Elective surgery access policy July 2015*), NB no change to registration dates; or
  - Report removal details as appropriate

Action required will depend on current reporting arrangements

## 207.4 Correction of Referral in Outcome code 98 definition

The following correction will be made in the next release of the VINAH manual

### 98- Referral awaiting additional information from referrer

Report this code where referrals are made for administrative purposes to allow continuation of existing episodes of care. Report this code when the referral is unintelligible, missing demographic or other required information and is sent back to the referrer.

## 207.5 Episode Care Plan Date re-instated in manual

Following queries to the HDSS help desk, it was identified data element Episode Care Plan Date was inadvertently removed from the current VINAH manual. The function of the data element has not changed and health services are required to continue to submit the date that an interdisciplinary care plan was first agreed. The correction will be made in the next release of the VINAH manual.

## 207.6 Timing rules

The VINAH manual lists the conditions under which it is mandatory to supply values for data elements. In a number of cases these mandatory requirements are not being enforced correctly or not at all.

The following changes to be made will ensure that the list of programs and conditions that determine if a data element is mandatory accurately reflects agreed business timing rules. The changes will be implemented in conjunction with the *Specifications for revisions to VINAH for 1 July 2017* due to be published December 2016.

### Episode Assessment – Barthel Index – Date/Time

<b>BR-DAT-EPS-021</b>	When an episode has an end date Episode Assessment- Barthel Index- Date/Times must be recorded	
<b>Data quality objective</b>	Data elements are reported as a result of certain events occurring	
<b>Validations</b>	E016	The field '<FieldName>' (<HL7 Field>) is mandatory for this Program/Stream <Program/Stream> at this point in time (<Timing>), but no value was supplied

### Episode Proposed Treatment Plan Completion

<b>BR-DAT-EPS-019</b>	When an episode has an end date, Episode Proposed Treatment Plan must be completed	
<b>Data quality objective</b>	Data elements are reported as a result of certain events occurring	
<b>Validations</b>	E016	The field '<FieldName>' (<HL7 Field>) is mandatory for this Program/Stream <Program/Stream> at this point in time (<Timing>), but no value was supplied

### Patient/Client Death Date

<b>BR-DAT-CLI-012</b>	When an episode has an end date and Episode Proposed Treatment Plan Completed = '27', Patient/Client Death Dates is mandatory

### Referral Out Place

<b>BR-DAT-EPS-018 ROU-003</b>	Where a Referral Out Date is reported, a Referral Out Place <del>must be provided when the episode has an end date</del> is mandatory	
<b>Data quality objective</b>	Data elements are reported as a result of certain events occurring	
<b>Validations</b>	E016	The field '<FieldName>' (<HL7 Field>) is mandatory for this Program/Stream (<Program/Stream>) at this point in time (<Timing>) but no value was supplied

## 207.7 Business Data Element Timing Summary

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### Key Symbol Reporting Obligation

C12	Either TCP Bed-Based Care Transition Date or TCP Home-Based Care Transition Date must be reported
C16	Mandatory for Specialist Clinics when Referral In Outcome is reported, and is not '98' or '99' has the value '010-Referral accepted-New appointment' or '020-Referral accepted-Review appointment' or '3-Referral accepted-Renewed referral'.
