

Emergency use group O red blood cells (RBC)







Emergency use RBC are **NOT RISK FREE**Use group specific/crossmatched blood wherever possible



CHECK for a valid group and screen/crossmatch and transfusion history



Take a pretransfusion sample **BEFORE** giving emergency blood



MOVE to group specific/crossmatched RBC ASAP



ASSESS the clinical requirement for holding emergency use group O RBC



ROTATE emergency use group O RBC on a regular basis



AUDIT emergency group O RBC use



INVESTIGATE incidents of inappropriate emergency group O RBC use and/or wastage



REPORT antibody formation/transfusion reactions after emergency group O RBC use to local and state **haemovigilance program**



PRESERVE O RhD negative blood for those that have no alternative
