- 1. The completed *MHWA* 158 *Report of psychiatrist* and this *MHWA* 159 *Report of Authorised Psychiatrist* must be sent to the Justice Secretary.
- 2. The Justice Secretary may order or direct the person be taken to the Designated Mental Health Service under section 535 or 540 of the *Mental Health and Wellbeing Act 2022* (as the case requires).

Notes

- 1. The Justice Secretary may make a Secure Treatment Order in relation to a person if the person is detained in a prison or other place of confinement, but not if the person is subject to a Court Secure Treatment Order and is detained in a prison or other place of confinement.
- 2. The Justice Secretary may make a direction that a person who is subject to a Court Secure Treatment Order be taken from a prison or other place of confinement to a Designated Mental Health Service.
- 3. A reference to the Justice Secretary includes a reference to the Chief Commissioner of Police if the person is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a police gaol within the meaning of the *Corrections Act* **1986** or being held in police custody on the order of a court.

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
