

SMOKE-FREE BUILDING ENTRANCE. PLEASE DON'T SMOKE HERE.



In Victoria, smoking is banned within four metres of an entrance to certain Victorian Government buildings, including: Parliament, the Victorian Courts and Victoria Police stations. Organisational policy may further restrict smoking in outdoor areas, so make sure you check the signs.
